Types. A simple sentence consists of only one clause. A compound sentence consists of two or more independent clauses. A complex sentence has at least one independent clause plus at least one dependent clause. A set of words with no independent clause may be an incomplete sentence, also called a sentence fragment.. A sentence consisting of at least one dependent clause and at least two ...

Countable vs Uncountable Nouns. Uncountable Nouns (or mass nouns) are nouns which cannot be counted. Generally, uncountable nouns do not have a plural form. Uncountable Noun Examples: music, time, space, travel, fun, happiness, art, sleep, currency, food, love Countable Nouns are those that refer to something that we can count. Countable nouns can be singular or plural.
